THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE

Context:

The author of Hebrews was concerned that his readers might walk away from their faith. They were likely immature Jewish believers who were deluged by false teachers and persecution. He needed to remind them that their hope was in Christ.

Likewise, we are experiencing intense pressure during a time of sickness and racial unrest. It's easy to cave to cultural norms or fail to trust God in the midst of storms. But God never leaves you. He is always there. You can hold on to Jesus. You can thrive by placing your hope in the faithfulness of God.

Key Scripture -

Hebrews 10:23

Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful.

DISCUSSION & APPLICATION

1. Times are hard. Jobs have been lost, people are sick, and cities are burning. How does God's faithfulness give you comfort as you navigate through your daily life?

2.	The text tells us to "hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering" Do you feel the temptation to doubt God? Why do you think it's important to continue to trust him?
3.	Many believers try to do the Christian life using their own power. But the author is clear: "for he who promised is faithful." How does God's faithfulness help you to hold on to Jesus? In what ways could you rely on God more?
