Context:

The problem many people have with Jesus isn't really a problem with Jesus. It's a problem with the truth *about* Jesus that seems unfair or illogical. It's hard to wrap our minds around the Lord's claim to be the "narrow road" to salvation. The fact is, God isn't accessible through just *any* religion. One can only have a relationship with God through *Jesus Christ*. That's it. There is no other way. Why? Because Jesus, alone, has the authority to save.
