THIS WEEK'S LESSON: OTHER PEOPLE'S SLIME



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

When you manipulate the slime just right it creates a surprising, popping sound. Jacob got surprised and slimed by someone else when Laban tricked him into marrying both of his daughters. We can still trust God's plan, even when we get slimed by other people. Genesis 29:1-30, Leah and Rachel



THANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Talk to your kids about some good surprises you've each had. Then talk about some bad surprises. How do we know that God is the one person who will never give us a bad surprise?



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- How did Laban trick Jacob?
- Why do people let other people down and hurt them?
- Who is the one person that will never let us down?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"But I call out to God. And the Lord saves me." Psalm 55:16 (NIRV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Have you broken a promise recently? Do you need to make amends for a recent mistake, with your kids or someone close to you? Do that this week. Ask God to forgive you, and ask for the grace to forgive others. Model to your kids how we can forgive other people and rely on God as the one person who will not let us down.
