THIS WEEK'S LESSON: SEEING PAST OUR SLIME



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Jacob had tricked and deceived his brother and his father, and was running for his life. But God showed Jacob a glowing stairway to Heaven, to prove that he still loved him and had a wonderful purpose for Jacob's life. THANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:
