



4 Simple Ways You Can Make This Lesson Stick With your Kids

Big Bible Stories for Little Kids Lesson 4

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: BIG MEAL

Use these four common times in a preschooler's day to reinforce this week's lesson:



DRIVING:

Listen to some praise and worship music on your next drive. Talk about God's great power and love. Remind your little ones that God can do anything.



PLAYING:

Try some games that require a little trust: leading little ones around blindfolded, trust falls, etc. Talk about what it means to trust someone. Remind your kids that they can always trust God.



EATING:

During mealtime, thank God that your family has enough food to eat. Talk about how Jesus multiplied the little boy's lunch of 5 small loaves of bread and 2 fish, so that over 5,000 people could have enough to eat.



SNUGGLING:

At bedtime, read some of the stories of Jesus from a picture book or child-friendly version of the Bible. Talk about Jesus' love and power. Talk to your little ones about what it means to trust Him as their Savior.
