

5 Simple Ways You Can Make This Lesson Stick With Your Kids

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: LOVE GOD

Use these four common times in a preschooler's day to reinforce this week's lesson:

DRIVING:

Today we talked about the first four of the Ten Commandments, which can be summed up in two words: "Love God!" On the drive home, ask your kids what the most important commandment is.

PLAYING:

When playing a game this week, ask your kids if they remember the rules of the game. Then ask the kids what God's most important "rule" is.

EATING:

Say a prayer of thanks before a meal, and tell God you love him. Have your child say the prayer with you.

SNUGGLING:

Read the first part of the Ten Commandments (Exodus 20:1-11) or read Matthew 22:36-40 (Jesus tells the greatest commandment) with your kids at reading or bed time.
