IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Today we read the story of the woman at the well and we discussed how we cannot hide our sin. Jesus knows what we do even in secret, but the good news is Jesus wants to help us get rid of our sin and give us a clean heart.



Make this week's lesson real:

AT BEDTIME:
